CHECKING ON A CHILD CARE PROVIDER'S REGULATORY COMPLIANCE HISTORY

It's important for parents to check on a provider's history to insure compliance with New York State Day Care Regulations. Parents should use this information to discuss any concerns they may have about any complaints or violations the provider may have had.

Information regarding a registered or licenses child care program can be found by visiting the <u>New</u> <u>York State Office of Children and Family Services (NYS OCFS) Facility Search</u> website and entering a program or providers name or the zip code and type of care. When you find the program or provider look to the right of the name and 'click here profile'. By clicking on a provider's link you will be able to view any regulatory compliance issues for up to six years. You can receive more information regarding New York State Child care regulations by visiting the NYS OCFS <u>website</u>.
